- Two types of abstracts -research and practice- may be submitted.
- 300 word abstracts in English, describing background, methods, results and conclusions of the research or practice.
- Single abstracts will be considered for oral or poster presentations; your format preference will be taken into account by the Scientific Committee.
- Proposals for Workshops and Other Activities are also welcome.
- All submissions will be received through the Conference Website and the deadline is October 31st, 2013. Acceptance notification will be given by December 15th, 2013.
